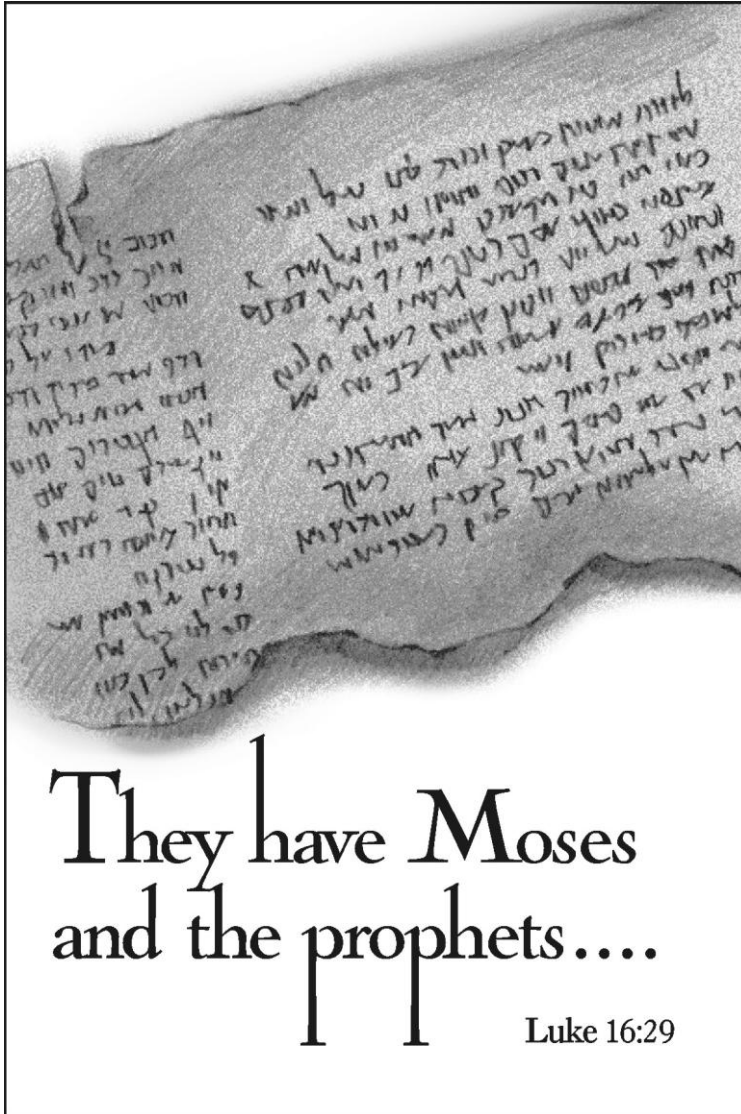

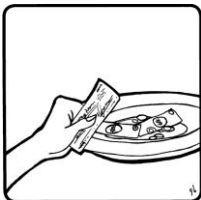

Food for Thought:

Try to imagine the population of the United States of America - around 316 million people. Now try to imagine a population almost 3 times bigger. That is the number of people worldwide that do not get enough food - over 870 million people. We are told that about 780 million people do not have access to clean drinking water. About 25,000 people die each day from hunger or causes related to hunger. Can you imagine every 4 days a small size town the size of 25,000 being wiped out?

Hunger does not just happen overseas. We are told that 50 million people, 17 million of them children, live without enough food here in the United States.
