

Canned Food Offering Today! The Canned Food Offering is collected on the first Sunday of each month. This food will be sent to the King George Social Services Food Bank where King George County residents who are in need of assistance may receive a two- or three-day emergency supply of food once a month.

April 10 is the conference-wide day to pray for General Conference: The United Methodist Council of Bishops has invited each annual conference to designate one day to hold a 24-hour prayer vigil for General Conference.
