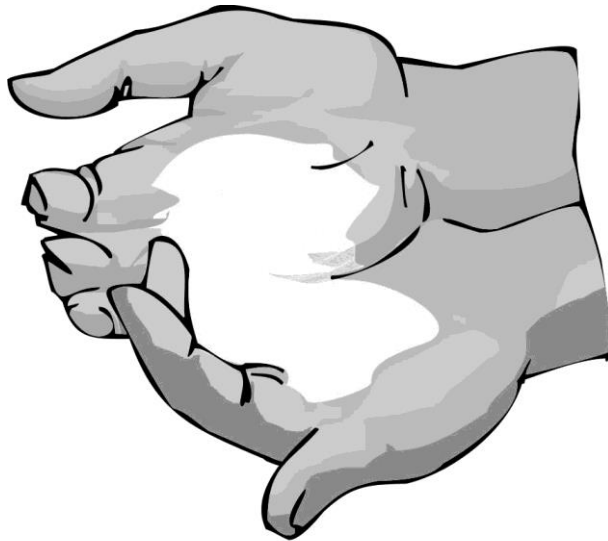

Lent: Living Our Baptismal Calling

Today, Lent 3: Confess

Do you confess Jesus Christ as your Savior, put your whole trust in his grace, and promise to serve him as Lord, in union with the church Christ opens to people of all ages, nations, and races?
